



GOVERNOR'S LODGE, ASOKORO-ABUJA

This building is conceived as a composition of Forms - solid, voids, and horizontal elements with forest of double height circular structural columns.

A covered external terrace forms an intermediate territory between the inside and the outside, which in turn gives the distinctive character to the building.

In both use and construction, this is really two separate buildings but beautifully integrated into a unified official and residential edifice.

The public space for meetings, conferences, banquettes and for meeting visitors are located in front, while the more private family sleeping quarters are at the rear.

Floors are clad in polished granite tiles while the walls are painted in first quality Dulux paint. Decorative gypsum ceiling gives each of the spaces an elegant and sumptuous appearance to the overall comfort of the occupant.

The Terrace below the roof which forms a Promenade gives the striking feature to the building.
